MUTUAL ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT

Whereas, the parties hereto recognize the likelihood that natural disasters, transportation mishaps or other emergencies hereafter occurring in their respective service areas could reach such proportions as to render each of the parties hereto incapable of effectively dealing with such emergencies utilizing each party's individual resources.

In consideration of the covenants herein contained, each of the undersigned agrees to furnish ambulance, rescue, emergency medical equipment, and personnel to the other undersigned, when such assistance is requested and such personnel and equipment is available. The determination as to the availability of personnel and equipment shall be made by the commanding officer of the agency receiving the request for assistance.

Requests for mutual aid under this agreement shall be made through Southern Oregon Regional Communications dispatchers.

It is agreed that each party waives and releases all claims whatsoever against the other for damage to property, loss of equipment, of injury to personnel or for the payment of any compensation whatsoever, arising in the course of, or as a result of, any assistance or lack of assistance rendered under the terms of this agreement. This provision does not waive the legal rights of any individual.

Nothing herein shall be construed to restrict either party from billing a third party for services rendered. In the event the third party is a member of either party's subscription plan, the undersigned agrees to accept insurance payments as payment in full.


In witness therefor, each of the undersigned has caused this agreement to be signed by it's duly authorized officers the day and year hereinafter indicated in connection with each such party. This agreement shall remain in effect so long as both parties provide emergency medical services. Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time without cause upon giving thirty (30) days notice to the other party.
